

**2009 INCENTIVE PROGRAM FOR
2008 TRAIL'S END POPCORN SALE**

PLEASE NOTE: All monies are non-transferable and non-refundable. They have no cash value. They would be applied to Summer Camp fees only – no Trading Post value. The full amount must be used in the 2009 Summer Camp season. All Camp programs are based on availability.

Levels of each Camping Opportunity (Summer Only):

- Level 1) Boy Scout Summer Camp
- Level 2) Cub Scout Day Camp or Webelos Extended Camp
- Level 3) Cub Scout Resident Camp
- Level 4) Boy Scout Specialty Camp

Incentive Program for each Level:

- Level 1) A Boy Scout or 2nd Year Webelos that sells a gross amount of popcorn totaling \$1,000 will have his week of Boy Scout Summer Camp paid in full.
- Level 2) A Cub Scout or 1st Year Webelos that sells a gross amount of popcorn totaling \$500 will have his week of Day Camp or Webelos Camp Session paid in full.
- Level 3) A Cub Scout that sells a gross amount of popcorn totaling \$800 will have his session of Cub Resident Camp paid in full.
- Level 4) A Boy Scout that sells a gross amount of popcorn totaling \$1,500 will have earned a week of Specialty Camp paid in full.

NOTE:

Level 1 – The Boy Scout or 2nd Year Webelos receives \$5 in Camp Credit for each \$100 sold up to \$500 then \$10 in Camp Credit for each \$100 earned between \$500 and \$1,000 in gross sales. At the \$1,000 mark he receives his Summer Camp fee paid in full.

Level 2 – The Cub Scout or 1st Year Webelos receives \$5 in Camp Credit for each \$100 earned up to the \$500 mark in which case he receives his Cub Day Camp or Webelos Extended fee paid in full.

Level 3 – The Cub Scout receives \$5 in Camp Credit for each \$100 earned up to the \$800 mark in which case he receives his Cub Resident Camp paid in full.

Level 4 – The Boy Scout earning \$1,500 receives no extra Camp Credit. **ONLY** the Specialty Camp fee will be paid in full. Sign-up for Specialty Camp is not automatic, it will be based on a first-come, first-serve basis.
