

## 2020 Black Rock District Klondike Derby Advanced trail

#### "Wilderness Survival University"

This year's Advanced Trail will be a test of Wilderness Survival and other Scout Skill. Teams of two Scouts (or three if needed) will have the chance to compete for first and second place all while earning (or partially earning) the Wilderness Survival Merit Badge. Scouts who wish to better prepare for the event may wish to refer to the Wilderness Survival Merit Badge and Scout Books.

Scouts who wish to complete the Wilderness Survival MB will camp overnight Friday in a shelter they have constructed at Base Camp Eagle. Check in at Base Camp Eagle after 1800 hours Friday. A light breakfast will be provided Saturday morning.

Saturday competition will be a full pack survival hike. Scouts should have a "shake down ready" pack with all items from the gear list. Scouts competing on the Advanced Trail should report to Base Camp Eagle at 0900 Saturday Morning. Teams of two Scouts will work together in the competition of Scout and Wilderness Survival Skill.

The cooking competition will be different this year. Teams will prepare a homemade, backpacking style, boil in bag lunch. The water for the cooking competition may be boiled on a backpacking stove OR LNT fire. The method of water boiling WILL NOT affect the team score. Bring your best homemade boil in bag recipe! If you don't have one there is plenty of information on the internet. You may also reference the attached sample.

ALL JUDGES WILL BE PROVIDED. Leaders may hike along but only as spectators.

All willing Scouts will complete the Wilderness Survival Merit Badge if they participate Friday Night and Saturday. All others will complete partial requirements. Two deep leadership will be provided for both Friday and Saturday.
