This year's Cub Klondike will take place at Hawk Mountain Scout Reservation on the 29th of January. The event will offer fun, exciting activities while encouraging the Scouts to work together as a team and work in winter conditions. The event is for Lions, Tigers, Wolves, Bears, Webelos, and Arrow of Light Scouts.

Cub Scout Packs/Dens will be placed in a group upon registration, and paired up with other Packs/Dens of Scouts. Groups will be limited to 10 Scouts per, with limited exceptions made. *If you are uncomfortable being placed with other Packs, please let us know ahead of time.

Program Areas: Scouts will travel together within a group to have fun and work on skills! Stations will include activities including but not limited to: Target Shooting, Games, Fire Building/Cooking, Compass Skills/Scavenger Hunt, and so much more!
