Twilight Camp is **6PM – 8PM (5:30 PM Registration on 1st Day)**

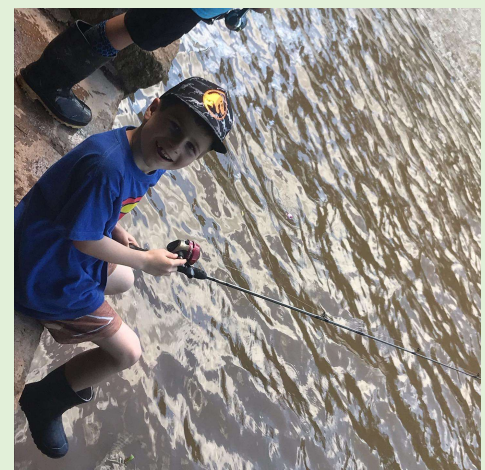
Program will be designed for Cub Scouts entering the Lion/Tiger program on **9/1/2022**
