THE FRONTIERSMAN AWARD

The Frontiersman Award is presented yearly by a unit or the district to recognize adults who gave gone above and beyond in service to youth. Any adult registered and serving at the unit/district level is eligible to receive the award. Every Frontier District unit (Pack, Troop, Crew, or Post) is entitled to select **ONE adult per year** to receive the award. The unit committee should screen, select and forward the response form to Linda Gilbert, Frontier District Advancement Chair, Hawk Mountain Council, BSA.

The only condition placed on the nominee by the District is that he/she must be present at any District Roundtable held the 2nd Wednesday of each month at the Pikeville Sportsman Club in Oley, PA to receive the award. The recipient must be informed prior to the monthly Roundtable so that they can make arrangements to be present.
